A Few Items:

1. Please bring rain gear. Rain is *extremely* rare, but it happens. The ride goes on anyway.
2. Please feel FREE to bring your own beverages for social hour which is at 5:30 every evening in the pavilion.
3. Please bring your own water bottles or water containers. The water at the ranch has been tested and it is as pure as pure can be pure. Water from the faucets/jugs is totally 100% potable. The caterer will provide water at dinner. We'll have limited water bottles available.
4. Please deposit all bottles and cans in the recycle bin, or take them home with you.
5. Please do NOT run generators after 9:00 p.m. or before 6:00 a.m.
6. **No refunds after January 1. NONE. ZERO.**
7. We do recommend shoes for the mules. Some of the terrain is extremely rocky. Boots do not stay on very well on these rides. So give this some thought, if you would. People complain to me about having to stop every 3 minutes for someone to put their mule's boots back on.
8. **ABSOLUTELY NO DOGS ON RIDES.** Dogs must be kept secured in your campsite or on a leash. Absolutely no exceptions. If your dog causes a rider to have an accident (even in camp) you are legally & financially responsible. Scoop up your dog's poo!! It can be put with your horse poop pile. For some reason, people just don't like stepping in dog poop. Imagine!
9. Horses are not allowed to participate in the Mule Ramble. Sorry. This *is* a MULE RIDE. Horses are *welcome* to participate in all other activities, however.
